"Katelin has a way of reading animals and knowing what they are about to do, she has a settling effect on them," said Carey. "This helps when we are clipping the dogs, as can sometimes they be nervous and scared.

"We both did a clipping course together and Katelin picked it up quicker than I did. She has left me in her wake. She can clip two dogs to my one and most times will then come and push me out of the way and finish mine – I'm just so proud of her.
