# TAMWORTH SHOWGROUND SOON TO BE KNOWN AS PACEWAY TAMWORTH

In a dramatic but strategic change in direction Harness Racing NSW has successfully secured the Tamworth Showground property thus ensuring uninterrupted racing for the local Club.

Following an extended period on the open market the Showground which is owned by the Tamworth Pastoral and Agricultural Association was open to final offers which closed Thursday 24/11.

For harness racing in Tamworth securing the property removed the possibility of a break in racing in the city, had the site been purchased by another owner or developer with the planned new facility still not progressed to the development application stage.

The purchase is a positive for harness racing in Tamworth, the North West Region and the Industry at large according to HRNSW Chief Executive John Dumesny. "The purchase of the established track site has considerable positives not least that the racing schedule at Tamworth will proceed uninterrupted" Dumesny said. "In securing this site the opportunities are endless especially in the harness racing activities. I must stipulate the 2017 Tamworth Show will be held on its traditional site the Tamworth Showground on March 24 and 25. The HRNSW Board has made an immediate commitment to а substantive infrastructure spend on the Showground inclusive of members and public facilities as well as an allweather cover to the existing race stalls. The ultimate aim is to convert the 200 permanent stables already in place into an accessible training centre for the current and new participants which HRNSW will aim to attract to Tamworth. Other works and strategies which enhance the productive capabilities for the property will be investigated in consultation with the Board of the THRC however the priority commitments will begin before settlement on February 1" Dumesny concluded. The immediacy of the offer was due to the closure of the offer period however HRNSW management had been undertaking costs analysis comparisons of the Showground and the green field site and other related industry impacts for some time. Investigations in relation to a valuation on the Showground property as well as heritage and contamination implications have been a prerequisite of the HRNSW discoveries.

Tamworth P&A Association President Brett Nies predicted the future direction of the Association and the Tamworth Show was encouraging and exciting. "For us, as a group of volunteers the sale is a great outcome as it preserves the recreational use of the Showground and it secures the Associations viability in the long term future, for the community. In accordance with our constitution the P&A will retain a portion of the property as our base and administration office".



THRC Deputy Chairman Robert Betts expressed the positive views of his fellow Board members in relation to the acquisition. "This is an exciting opportunity taken at the right time which will ensure continuity of harness racing in Tamworth, with ownership of a North West facility renewing enthusiasm amongst THRC members" For all of the harness racing community these new and upgraded facilities will ensure the sustainability of harness racing in this region" Mr Betts concluded.

**Tamworth Mayor Col Murray** in discussions with HRNSW was fully supportive of the decision made which preserved the tradition of the sport in Tamworth and he looked forward to future growth in this activity.

### **THRC Chairperson 2016-18**

The THRC Board finalised the application process on Thursday 1/12 for the position of Chairperson and is excited that Julie Maughan has accepted the position for the next two years. The Club feels lucky to receive applications from high quality candidates to lead a board that has made great progression over the last four years, which sets a great platform for the future. Outgoing Chairman Terry Browne has made an exceptional commitment over the last two years that has seen changes made to THRC that will benefit staff, participants and patrons for years to come. Julie Maughan brings a life time of Harness Racing experience and strong management skills to the board at a time when the club is transitioning into an exciting new future underpinned by exceptional performance both on and off the track in recent years. She joins Joyce Walsh, Graham Moon, Greg McDonell and Robert Betts for an exciting next two years at Paceway Tamworth.

After a recent incident on the track during training the Club reminds drivers and trainers that **good communication is vital in keeping people safe.**The number one priority is safety and not 'who was on the track first'. **Incident reporting is mandatory** and gives information on the nature and frequency of near miss incidents.

### **Pryde's Corner**

Which Feed is Best? Here are the top 3 things you should ask before using a race feed:

- **1. Will the feed fuel muscles?** During sprints, a racehorse's muscles can <u>only</u> use glucose for fuel. The starch (the white stuff in the middle of a grain) in grains like corn and barley is pure glucose <u>BUT</u> a horse will only fully digest and absorb the starch as glucose if it is well cooked before it is fed. Research shows that extruded grains like those in our Pryde's racing feeds are the easiest to digest and absorb as glucose.
- 2. Will the feed build muscle? A horse needs muscle to run, so a big focus of training racehorses is developing the muscles that power them. The quality of the protein in a feed has a huge impact on how easily a horse will build muscle. Feeds like the Pryde's racing feeds that use soybean as their primary protein will support excellent muscle development. Feeds that use unnamed 'vegetable protein meals' or cottonseed meal are less likely to provide the building blocks needed for muscles to fully develop.
- 3. Are high quality ingredients used to make the feed? Horse feeds are either made to a set recipe or they are made via a 'least-cost' formulation. Feeds made by the 'least-cost' formulation method will have generic ingredients like 'cereal grains', 'vegetable protein meals' and 'vegetable oils' on their ingredients list and literally use the ingredients available at the lowest cost to the manufacturer. Cheap feed ingredients are cheap for a reason, so feeds made with these ingredients are almost always of inferior quality. All of the feeds made at Pryde's EasiFeed are made to set recipes using high quality ingredients to provide the best quality nutrition.
