Sky Zone has a variety of different climbing walls, with varying levels of difficulty. There is also The Leap of Faith and Sky Drop for the more adventurous child. Their auto-belay braking system also means kids can climb on their own, and they can even time themselves or race a friend on the Speed Walls. Climbers must be at least five years old or at least 110 cm tall, so if you have children who are not big enough to climb, there is also Sky Jump and a toddler play area. Sessions are run on the half hour every hour. Bookings are recommended during peak times.
